

CONSENT FOR A FUNCTIONAL CAPACITY ASSESSMENT AND INFORMATION TRANSFER

Toimintakykyarvio.fi is a service developed in Valteri Centre for Learning and Consulting. The purpose of conducting a functional capacity assessment is to support learning and studying. The information in the assessment is used to promote and support the pupil's learning and studying both during pre- and comprehensive school and after he or she moves on to further studies. The goal is to ensure that pupils receive support in their studies based on their own functional capacity, and that the support is also available when studies start after comprehensive school. With your consent, the young person's guidance counsellor, teacher, assistants and, if necessary, other experts mentioned below participate in the assessment in addition to the pupil and the guardians.

All persons working at the school are bound by professional secrecy. According to Section 40 of the Basic Education Act, Section 32 of the General Upper Secondary Schools Act, and Section 42 of the Vocational Education and Training Act, the persons responsible of providing education may not disclose to outsiders what they have learned in the execution of tasks related to education about the personal circumstances and economic standing of pupils or the members of their families. The information will not affect the pupil's assessment.

Additional information on transferring necessary information:

According to Section 40(4) of the Basic Education Act, if a pupil under the age of 18 transfers to education or activities provided by another education provider, the former education provider must without delay forward information necessary for arranging instruction for the pupil to the new education provider. The information may also be provided at the request of the new education provider. This means that providing necessary information does not require the consent of a guardian. The party providing the information determines what information is necessary.
